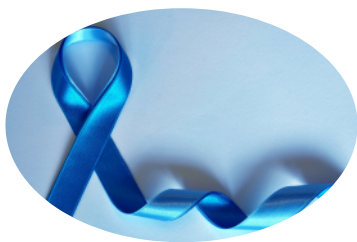


Maintaining sense & sensibility in healthcare in the Digital Era

Meet Peter! A cancer survivor story!

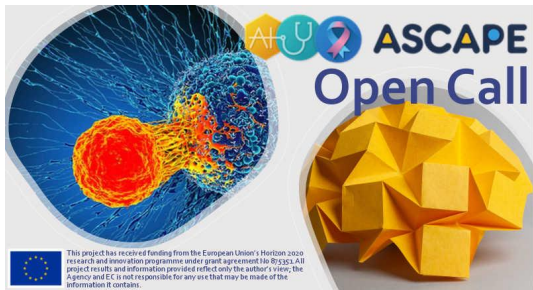

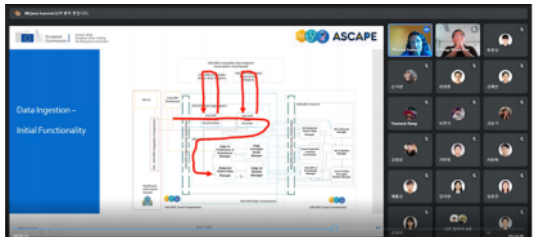

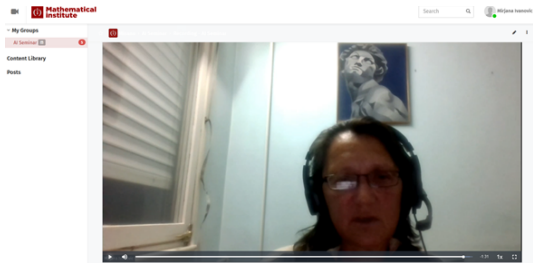
